Ger graduated as a building engineer in architecture and town planning at the **Technical University, Eindhoven** in the Netherlands. He practiced architecture in several firms and started his own architectural office in 1984, which he later associated with colleagues for larger projects in housing and utilitarian building complexes. Gradually specialization developed in planning, cost calculation and specification contracts.

In 1985 education attracted again through a part time position as lecturer at the **Technical Teacher Training Institute in Eindhoven** where pedagogical, didactical and organizational innovations were introduced and implemented in courses for building construction and management. The various experiences with multi-media instructional design, development of learning plans, new information and communication technology and organizational analysis for teachers in vocational education and training proved a solid base for sharing the gained expertise and experiences abroad with countries in transition and emerging countries.

Since 1991 Ger has participated in complex international projects and developed himself in positions including trainer, developer, consultant and project manager in the sectors technique and education. Subsequent to 1994 Ger has been part of short term assignments, geographically distributed over Eastern Europe, Central and South East Asia, Africa and the Middle East, under the governance of **Fontys University of Applied Sciences**.

Long term assignments as a full time manager on national reforms in Central Asia and Russia contributed, in 2001, to the establishment of **Fontys**

International Projects in a position as Managing Director of the unit where the focus changed for business development strategy, subsidy management, financial and economic analysis and partnership development.
